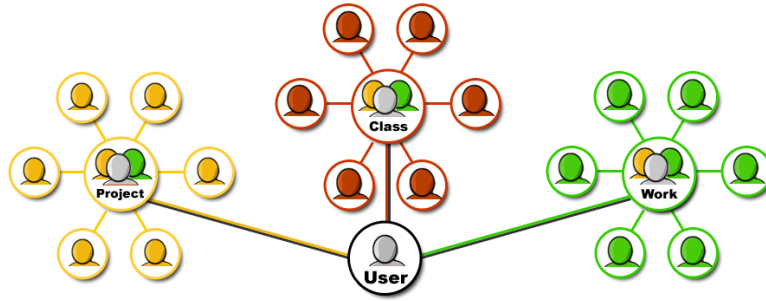


Google Groups
