

How do I submit my IRB protocol application & supporting materials?

Tell Me

1. Applications must be submitted using [IRBIS](#), the online application system.
2. Review the [Guidance: Examples of Activities that Do and Do Not Require UNC Charlotte IRB Review and Approval](#) document for guidance on activities that may or may not require IRB review and approval BEFORE you begin an application through IRBIS.



Note

If the Investigator is a student then the protocol application requires the signature of the Investigator and Responsible Faculty. The signature page of the application may be submitted in-person, via campus mail, by fax, or scanned and emailed.
