

Where can I get training/certification on Effort Reporting for grants and contracts?

Tell Me

1. The Federal government requires periodic review and certification that confirms the distribution of salaries for employees who received full or partial compensation and/or are cost shared on sponsored projects.
2. To meet this requirement, UNC Charlotte uses the after-the-fact method of accounting for effort using certified effort reports that represent a "reasonable" reflection of employee effort on a sponsored project(s).
3. UNC Charlotte requires that effort for faculty and staff supported by sponsored programs be certified periodically on at least an annual basis.
